





DIRECTIONS:

Have your preschooler cut out the hats so they can practice using a scissors and cutting lines. If they are ready for more advanced cutting, they could cut out each hat instead.

Mix the cards up on the table and have your kid stack the hats in the order that was found in the book.

On the back of the cards (or on the front), write the numbers 0 through 12. Your child can then practice stacking the hats in numerical order forward 0 -> 12 and backwards 12 -> 0, and in our home we even practiced skip counting by twos with them (2, 4, 6, 8, 10, 12).
